The aim of the Residency is to assist and encourage both established and emerging practitioners, offering an opportunity to research and work alongside others in a very unique, creative environment.

- **Friday 16th - Friday 23rd August (Open to all forms of design and craft disciplines)**
- **Friday 13th - Friday 20th September (Open to all forms of design and craft disciplines)**

Please note currently this is a research residency that provides self-catering accommodation and a studio space. Any tools/equipment required as part of the research residency must be provided by yourself.

Design & Crafts Council of Ireland Bursary 2019  
RESIDENCIES AT TYRONE GUTHRIE CENTRE**

1. Bursary awards will be awarded to craftspeople/designers from all fields born or living in Ireland to enable them to spend 1 week at the Tyrone Guthrie Centre at Annaghmakerrig, the craftspeople/designers workplace in Monaghan.
2. Craftspeople/designers will be selected on the basis of their application and the project/research they intend to further during their residence.
3. Bursary provided by Design & Crafts Council of Ireland (DCCol) must be acknowledged in all publicity material associated with the project. DCCol logos are available from [communications@dccoi.ie](mailto:communications@dccoi.ie) reserves the right to publicise the awarding of the bursary. Failure to acknowledge DCCol appropriately may deem the bursary invalid and funding relating to bursary may need to be refunded to DCCol.
4. Successful candidates are required to provide a short written report / update to the DCCol on or before 31<sup>st</sup> October 2019. Failure to do so may deem the bursary invalid and funding relating to bursary may need to be refunded to DCCol.
5. Applicants must be originally from or currently resident in Ireland.
6. Craftspeople/designers will be selected on the basis of their application and the project/research they intend to further during their residence.
7. The bursary will cover self-catering lodging costs, but does not include travel expenses and candidates must make their own travel arrangements.
8. No cash alternative will be offered and the bursary cannot be passed on to a third party.
9. Residency dates indicated are non-negotiable. Failure to participate on set dates after confirming your place may result in liability for costs of residency.
10. All applicants will be advised of DCCol's decisions via email.
11. All applications must be accompanied by
  - 1) A current biography and/ or cv, outlining details of career to date
  - 2) A statement of interest outlining the intentions or specific body of work for which the bursary would be used, including time scale
  - 3) Support image material, in jpeg, that may be relevant to this application
